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Japan Announces Beef and Pork SGs for JFY 2019 Q4

Report Highlights:

On May 31, Japan's Ministry of Finance announced the safeguard (SG) trigger levels for beef and pork for the fourth quarter of Japanese Fiscal Year 2019 (January 2020-March 2020). This follows a March 31 announcement which detailed trigger levels for the first three quarters of JFY 2019. The beef SG trigger is set at 117 percent of the previous year's trade while the pork SG trigger level is set at 119 percent of the three previous years of trade.

General Information:

On May 31, 2019, Japan's Ministry of Finance announced the safeguard trigger (SG) levels for beef and pork for the fourth quarter of Japanese Fiscal Year (JFY) 2019, based on Japan's cumulative actual imports from April 2018 to March 2019. Japan had already announced the beef and pork SG trigger levels for the first three quarters of JFY 2019 as well as the full year trigger level for the pork special safeguard (SSG) in late March (see JA9045). All three safeguards have a double trigger system based on imports from all trade partners and imports from countries with which Japan does not have an economic partnership agreement (non-EPA).

SG trigger levels for beef and pork are calculated on a cumulative quarterly basis.

In December 2018 and February 2019, Japan made revisions to all three safeguard calculations following the entry into force of the Comprehensive and Progressive Agreement for Trans-Pacific Partnership (CPTPP) and the Japan-EU EPA (see <u>JA9026</u>). If any of these safeguards trigger, the tariff increases apply only to countries that do not have a free trade agreement with Japan, including the United States.

Actual Trade in the First Month of JFY 2019

Also on May 31, Japan's Ministry of Finance announced actual import data for April 2019, the first month of JFY 2019. Chilled beef imports from all trade partners was 25,860 MT (30 percent of Q1 trigger) and from non-EPA countries was 11,480 MT (28 percent of Q1 trigger). Frozen beef imports from all partners was 41,408 MT (39 percent of Q1 trigger) and from non-EPA partners was 15,518 MT (42 percent of Q1 trigger).

For the pork SG, imports from all partners was 99,230 MT (36 percent of Q1 trigger) and from non-EPA countries was 22,301 MT (28 percent of Q1 trigger). For the pork SSG, imports from all partners was 99,236 MT (10 percent of annual trigger) and from non-EPA countries was 22,301 MT (8 percent of annual trigger).
